Competitions will be held in Wisdom Public School, Mirza (Assam), as per the schedule which will be prepared by the CBSE observer in the presence of coaches and managers, one day before.

- ✓ Shared accommodation shall be provided at Wisdom Public School, Mirza (Assam)
- ✓ Shared accommodation shall be provided for Players, Coach & Manager.
- ✓ Parents are not allowed to stay in school.
- ✓ Schools should bring their flag and plaque card for March Past and Opening Ceremony.
- ✓ Two school flags are required for March past and hosting.

Boarding and Lodging

- ✓ Boarding & Lodging Charges will be *Rs 500/- (Rs. Five Hundred only) per day, per head (* Subject to change as per CBSE Organizing Rule).
- ✓ All the Team Managers and player accommodation will be provided by the school. No accommodation for parents or any other person accompanying.
- ✓ No costly items or jewelry etc. are to be brought to the campus during championship as the school will not be responsible for the loss of any personal belongings.
- ✓ All outside team will carry Mosquito net/repellent, bed sheet and pillow cover.

NOTE:-

- ✓ All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc. in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation.
- ✓ **The participants must be physically present for reporting one day prior to the commencement of the event (out station team).**

GENERAL RULES FOR THE CONDUCTION OF KHO-KHO BOYS COMPETITION 2025-26

1. The rules as adopted by the Kho- Kho Federation of India apply unless otherwise modified in these rules.
2. All the matches at Cluster level will be played on Knockout basis. In case the numbers of teams reporting are 8 or less than 8, the tournament may be conducted on league cum knock out basis.
3. From each Cluster, the first & second position winning teams will qualify to participate in the CBSE National Championship.
4. All the matches at National level shall be played on league cum knock out basis.
5. **At National level:** All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way that by and large no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches.
6. In matches played on league basis, "points for minus the total points against" shall decide the tie. Should the tie still persist; it shall be decided by "spin of coin".
7. A team shall consist of a maximum number of twelve players
8. The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.

NOTE:

1. First two teams (winner and runner-up) will be provided with Merit Certificates. Other than the winners, all participants will be provided with Participation Certificate who actually participates in the tournament, which can be downloaded from CBSE website.
2. Protest, if any, has to be submitted in writing by the team Coach/Manager with the Chief Referee, within 15 min of the announcement of result. The decision of the Jury of Appeal shall be final.
 1. The Jury of Appeal shall include:
 - a. Principal Organizing School
 - b. Organizing Secretary
 - c. CBSE Observer
 2. All teams must report at least a day before the commencement of the championship.
 3. The Host School will not be responsible for any miss happening (MISHAP) during the Championship or during journey.
 4. All the participating teams (OUT STATION) will be provided lodging facilities. (Adequate and safe with clean bath and toilet)
 5. Accommodation will not be provided to the parents accompanying the participants.
 6. **Security Deposit:** You are required to deposit a sum of **Rs 3000.00 (Three thousand)** as a security deposit, which shall be refunded in full at the time of departure in case no damage is detected in and around the school campus when the team vacates the venue. This is also applicable to local teams.

The boarding charges shall be *Rs. 500/- per head per day including bedding charges. It is advised that from the health and safety point of view, all participating teams dine in the mess arranged by the Organizing school. (* Subject to change as per CBSE organizing rule.) BREAKFAST, LUNCH, EVENING SNACKS and DINNER will be served ONLY on production of COUPONS, which is supposed to be collected at the time of ARRIVAL & FIRST REGISTRATION.

However, this amount shall not be charged from the players/ teams who are not staying in the venue, and are not taking any meal from the organizing school. If the teams/ individuals are not staying in the venue, but taking meal(s) from the organizing school, then the participating school shall pay **Rs.300/-** per participant per day for meal(s), irrespective of the number of meals taken in a day. (Note: The participating schools should prefer staying in the venue schools keeping in view the safety & security of the participants. In case the players/ teams want to stay outside at their own, then the participating players/ teams should bring a written undertaking/ permission from their school Principal on school letter head regarding the same)

7. Teams which are coming from local schools and wish to have lunch, those schools should intimate us through email before one day, prior to the commencement of the tournament.
8. Discipline / decorum of all the students should be strictly looked after by their respective Coach/Team Manager/Teacher.
9. The Out Station participating schools will deposit **payments against meals on full day basis** and no part payment will be accepted and the **participating schools will not insist for refund of part payment.**
10. Food Timings will be intimated on arrival.

PARTICIPATING SCHOOL

- ✓ Every affiliated school shall be entitled to enter its athlete/team in the CBSE Sports and Games Competitions. As soon as Calendar is uploaded on the Board's website, the schools may fill-in the online discipline-wise Entry Proforma. No school will be permitted to participate unless they fill the online discipline-wise Entry Proforma and by-hand Entry Proforma would not be accepted.
- ✓ No team will be permitted to play unless accompanied by a teacher/coach at the venue.
- ✓ In no circumstances the composition of team shall change from Cluster/Zone to National. In extra ordinary circumstances the changes may be permitted, but only with prior permission from the CBSE, in writing.
- ✓ All expenses on items like travel, food, kit etc. will have to be borne by the participating School.
- ✓ Dining in the mess arranged by the host school is mandatory for the teams that opt to stay in the school provided accommodation.
- ✓ Every player/team shall carry with them the required documents as mentioned under title "Eligibility".
- ✓ Every team will carry their school flag, for the purpose of March past and to be used during the various ceremonies. Participation in March past is compulsory, failing which their right to participate can be forfeited.
- ✓ It is not obligatory on the part of Organizing School to provide food & transport facility to school/teams making their own stay arrangements. Also, it is the responsibility of the school/teams staying outside, to collect information in regard to matches/fixtures/program etc.
- ✓ Any non-designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained for any matter at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the premises.

ACCREDITED REPRESENTATIVES (TEACHER/ COACH/ MANAGER)

- ✓ All the teams shall be accompanied by a Teacher/Coach/Manager designated by the participating school Principal.
- ✓ No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official.
- ✓ No team shall be accompanied by any parent.
- ✓ No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
- ✓ No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the play field along with the teams.

COLOURS

- ✓ All the participating teams shall compete in the Inter-School tournament in their respective playing uniform with the prescribed color of their school and numbered.

- ✓ In case of clash of playing jersey color, it shall be decided by the spin of coin as to which team will have to change playing uniform.

ENTRIES

- ✓ As soon as the Sports Calendar has been uploaded, it becomes the responsibility of the schools to fill in the entry Proforma online.
- ✓ Each school shall be entitled to enter only one team or individual for each tournament/meet/event.
- ✓ Soon after filling-in the entry Proforma, schools shall make travel bookings and send the information to the Organizing school for making the necessary arrangements.

Whatsoever the reason may be, on the spot entry and late entry will not be entertained.

WITHDRAWING SCHOOL

- ✓ If a school, after filling-in its entry, wishes to withdraw from a tournament/meet, it shall give a written request of its intention to do so to the Organizing Secretary/School.
- ✓ School withdrawing without informing/requesting the Organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of Rs.1000/-.

ELIGIBILITY

Age:

The player should be within the particular age group on 31 December of the year of competition.

- Only bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-School tournaments/meets. Feeding any non bonafide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.
- A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.
- Incomplete information in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.
- Any violation in eligibility (over age or Impersonation) shall be dealt according to rules.
- The original eligibility Performa of the Athletes/Players/Teams qualifying to participate from Cluster/Zone level to National level will have to be certified by the Organizing school at the Cluster/Zone level as the case may be and forwarded to the National Organizing School, immediately after their Cluster/Zone level competition is over.
- Medical checkup may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing school in the cases of overage suspicion.
- A player shall be under 14, 17 & 19 years of age on 31 Dec 2026.
 - Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2013
 - Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2010
 - Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2008
- All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc. in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation.
- The player's right to participate forfeits if fails to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.
- Any team not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament/meet shall not be permitted to participate.

PROTEST

- ✓ Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within 15 minutes of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand).
- ✓ Such a protest will be considered by Jury of Appeal, consisting of following: -
 - Principal, Organizing School
 - Organizing Secretary
 - CBSE Observer
 - One or two technically qualified people present at the venue
- ✓ The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue. In case the protest is uphold, the protest fee shall be refunded to the protesting school otherwise the fee shall be forfeited.

The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

IT SHALL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING ON ARRIVAL
AT VENUE-

- (i) The documents for verification in original if asked for.
- (ii) The team photo with school Principal along with the entry Performa, countersigned by the concerned Principal shall be produced at the time of entry in the School Campus.
- (iii) To provide CBSE registration number for student/player studying in class IX and above.
- (iv) Identity Cards to be brought by the students and coaches duly stamped and signed by the principal.
- (v) Proof of the payment of CBSE Annual Sports fee for the year 2025-26
- (vi) To supply the eligibility Performa filled-in online, countersigned by the concerned principal.
- (vii) Participant list from school and Participant I-Card downloaded from CBSE games website duly signed by principal.
- (viii) All Annexure format, registration form and travel itinerary properly filled and duly signed by principal.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons.

- 1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
 - 2. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
 - 3. Misbehavior on ground by athlete or accompanying official.
 - 4. Use of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official.
 - 5. Misbehavior with Officials/Opponents by athlete or accompanying official.
 - 6. Indiscipline at the place of stay by athlete or accompanying official.
 - 7. Damaging the school/accommodation property.
 - 8. Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by athlete or accompanying official.
 - 9. Non participation in March Past.
- ✓ The Organizing School in no case shall show the eligibility performa or any other paper of a team to anyone who lodges the protest. It is only jury of appeal's prerogative to verify all the documents.
 - ✓ The Organizing school shall submit details of the defaulters to the Jt. Director (Sports) reporting the names of the schools/athletes, in a separate cover. All such defaulters will be debarred from the participation in CBSE Inter School Sports and Games Competition for the next year. If any of such school resorts to unfair means again, in the subsequent years, it will be debarred for three years.
